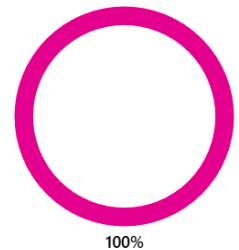

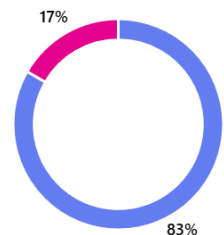

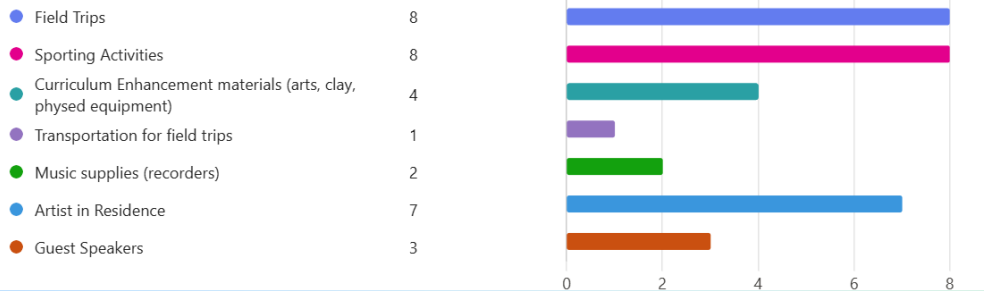

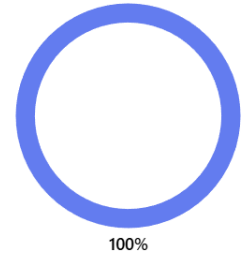

3. Do you believe the school fees are reasonable for the benefits your child receives?

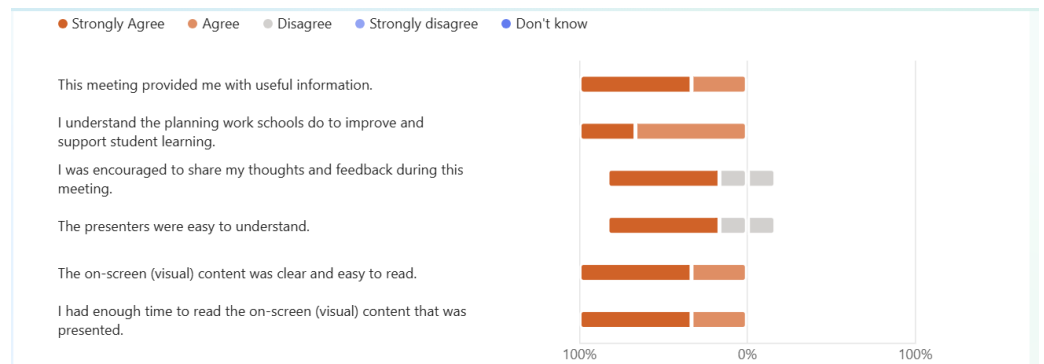

- Valuable insight to student survey

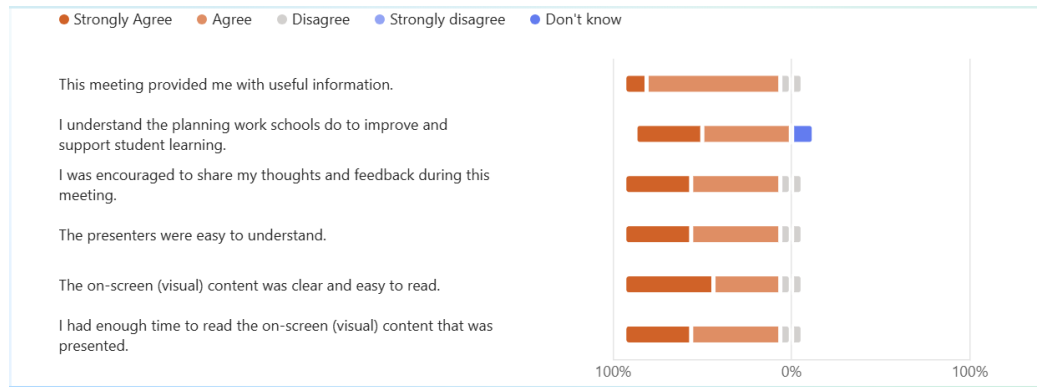
What did you like about this meeting?
